
## Embroidered Needlebook Blair Stocker/Wise Craft Handmade





Finished size (when closed)- Approximately  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " tall x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " wide

Stitch up this charming gingham needlebook and learn the foundational stitches of Chicken Scratch embroidery—a vintage hand embroidery technique used to add decorative hand stitched details to gingham check fabric.

## Supply List

- \*One 7" x 5" piece of gingham fabric in quilting cotton or linen weight for cover (see note below)
- One 7" x 5" piece of fabric for the inside cover (I used Liberty of London Tana Lawn)
- One 7" x 6" piece of fabric for the inside pocket
- One 5" x 4" piece of wool felt for inside page
- One 7" x 5" piece of fusible interfacing or quilt batting
- Template of stitch pattern (provided)
- 1-2 colors of 6-strand embroidery floss
- 6" embroidery hoop
- Size 3 embroidery needle
- 12" length of ribbon for closure
- Fabric scissors
- Sewing machine with coordinating thread
- Iron and ironing surface
- Thread snips (optional)

\*Note- It is very important that the individual gingham squares measure ¼" sq on your chosen fabric, which is a standard size in gingham. Using larger or smaller sized squares will not give you the best result for this project.
