Luminous Pyramids- Finding the "Darks" in your Low Volume Fabrics 3 or 6 hour class options

Pale or "low volume" fabrics offer a stunning range of possibilities in quilts, especially when thoughtfully separated into color value groups. While it may initially seem challenging to discern the subtle variations in light fabrics, training your eye to recognize these nuances opens up a world of creative potential.

Starflake Quilt


Create the Starflake Quilt in this workshop and explore complex color value relationships between fabrics pulled from your stash and divided into 3 values. Exhibited at QuiltCon 2019, the Starflake design will stretch your design skills as you learn to use the same fabric for different values, set inspiring design parameters, and make consistent design decisions. Intermediate quilters welcome.

Boro-inspired Quilt 6 hour

In Blair's book Wise Craft Quilts, she shares a popular project inspired by Japanese Boro cloth, which is pieced together from patched and mended fabric. This workshop, suitable for confident beginners who enjoy hand stitching, will guide you in creating your own Boro-inspired quilt using your favorite fabrics, trims, and threads. Design prompts will encourage exploration of patchwork composition, color palette, and patch placement.



Modern Chicken Scratch Embroidery 3 hour

Learn the calming vintage stitching technique called Chicken Scratch embroidery. Blair will guide students through the basic supplies that will ensure success as you create a stunning square star motif panel. This handstitched technique on gingham produces a lacy optical illusion—it's pure magic! The finished panel can be transformed into a pillow or used in a larger project. This workshop is open to all skill levels, though prior hand embroidery experience is helpful.
